

FOUR-PATCH KID'S QUILT

revised 2008

Finished quilt size: 40" x 56"

Finished block size: 8" across

MATERIALS LIST:

Front of Quilt: $1 \frac{1}{4}$ yards - main or theme print
 $\frac{3}{4}$ yard EACH of 2 co-ordinating fabrics for pieced blocks

Back of Quilt: $1 \frac{3}{4}$ yards of co-ordinating fabric

CUTTING: Cut 5 $8 \frac{1}{2}$ x 45" strips from the main or theme fabric
Cut 17 $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " blocks from these five strips and set aside
Cut 4 $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips from each of the two co-ordinating prints

PIECING:

1. see illustration #1
2. Sew 2 co-ordinating strips together to form an $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 45" strata -
(be sure it is $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " to fit the $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " block)
3. Press seams to darker fabric
4. From each strata, cut nine $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
5. Sew these rectangles together to make eighteen $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " blocks
(see illustration #2)
6. Sew the main fabric blocks to the pieced, co-ordinating fabric blocks
(see illustration #3)

You can use pillowcase assembly to add batting and backing if you choose.
Pauline will demonstrate this procedure if needed.

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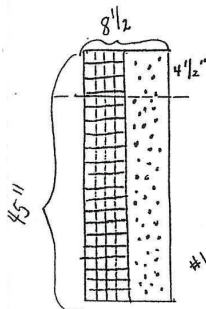

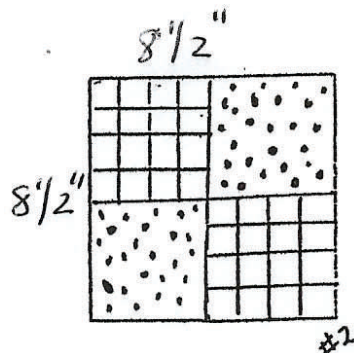

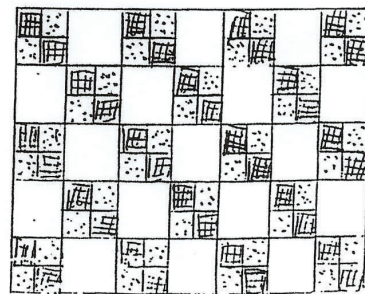
