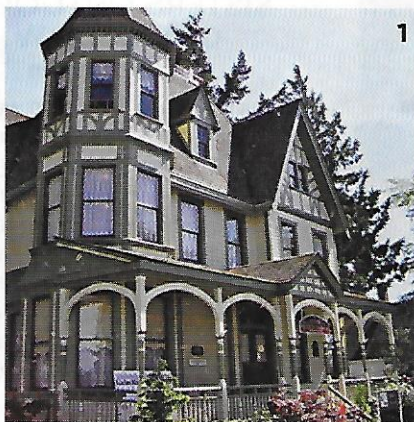

View quilts from the 1600s and 1700s, which are some of the museum's oldest, and international quilts from India and Africa (through July 14).

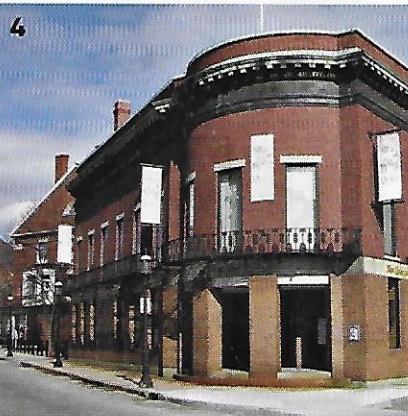

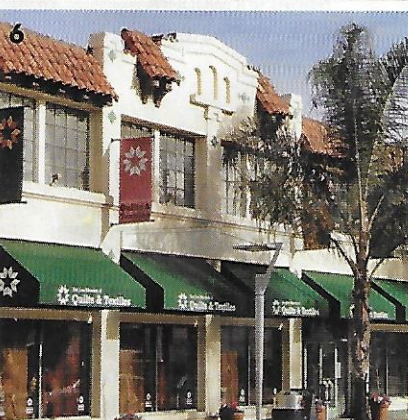

Four galleries showcase Studio Art Quilt Associates H2O! art quilts interpreting water (through July 14).

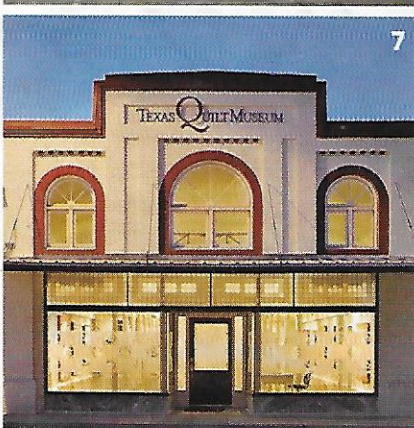
